Curbside Recycling Guidelines

The Village of Covington provides curb-side recycling to every Covington residence. The chart below describes acceptable recycling items.

	ACCEPTABLE RECYCABLES	NOT ACCEPTABLE
PLASTIC	All plastic bottles #1-17 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Labels do not need to be removed Please Rinse 	Caps Bowls, buckets or tubs Oil jugs, Styrofoam Film cases or Plastic bags
GLASS	Clear, brown, green & blue glass bottles and Jars in which food products are packaged <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Labels do not need to be removed Please Rinse 	Lids Window or drinking glass Light bulbs Broken glass
PAPER	Newspaper including glossy inserts Magazines, telephone books & catalogs Paperboard boxes (cereal, snacks, etc) Junk Mail (direct mail, envelopes with or without windows, flyers, etc.) Soft drink and beer cartons Brown grocery sacks Corrugated cardboard (flattened in 2' x 2' bundles)	Pizza boxes that are contaminated with food or grease. Tissues, paper plates, cups or bowls
CANS	Aluminum and metal beverage cans Steel and tin food cans Empty aerosol cans <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Labels do not need to be removed Please rinse 	Paint cans Coat hangers

Styrofoam must be placed inside your trash toter. It is not a curbside recyclable item. Recycling toters cannot be used for trash. Unacceptable items including trash that are placed in the recycling toter may result in an additional charge.
