Curbside Trash Pickup Guidelines

Trash must be bagged, securely fastened and placed inside your toter with the lid closed. Styrofoam must be placed inside your trash toter. It is not a curbside recyclable item. Toters are to be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on your trash day and returned to your property by 7 p.m. the same day.

Toters must be 2 feet clear of any obstruction. (telephone poles, mailboxes, cars, etc) If multiple toters are used, please allow 2 feet in between toters with the arrows on the lids facing the street. (handles towards the house)

Bulk items (furniture, tree limbs, appliances) must also be placed at the curb. Please be sure these items are unobstructed from mailboxes, telephone poles and overhead power lines. Bulk items are collected by a secondary truck for an extra fee. Extra toters will be provided upon request for a fee of \$5.00 per month.

Bags or boxes of trash on the ground or trash cans other than the Covington provided toters will be picked up for an extra fee.

If your toter or bulk item is not accessible from the street it will not be picked up.

If your trash or bulk item is not picked up, please contact the Government Center for further instructions.

If Village staff moves your toter so that it can be picked up, they will not return it to the previous location. They will instead place it at a location that will allow it to be picked up. Please place your trash toter at that location on your trash day.

Toters are the property of the Village of Covington. Customers are responsible for their assigned toter. If a toter is damaged by no fault of the resident it will be repaired or replaced at no charge. If you need to request a new toter, replacement toter, please call the Government Center at 937-473-3420

The Village will again provide curb-side pickup of large items the week after the garage sales. This service will be provided to residential trash customers at no additional cost the week of June 8th.
