## Spring Street Reconstruction Project

The work on the Spring Street Project is on schedule and progressing nicely. The concrete work is expected to be completed with the next week. Grading and seeding will be completed shortly after the completion of the sidewalks. The tentative schedule for asphalt to be completed is the third week of August.

## Sidewalk Maintenance Program

The 2015 sidewalk program has been completed. Sidewalks to be replaced under the 2016 sidewalk maintenance program will soon be identified and notification letters will be sent out to affected property owners. We would like to thank village residents for the support that you have given us while completing this year's sidewalk maintenance project and look forward to another successful year in 2015.

## Downtown Public Parking Lot

The new public parking lot that is being installed adjacent to the Government Center is now under construction. This parking lot was partially funded through a \$40,000 CDBG grant. It will add much needed additional parking to the downtown area. We expect this project to be completed by the end of September.

Utilizing the savings realized through reduced labor costs, we have purchased additional yellow lid recycling toters. These recycling toters are available to village residents at no additional cost.
