SUMMARY OF REFUSE COLLECTION RULES

- Your refuse pickup location remains the same.
- Your refuse and recycling collection day remains the same.
- Lids should be closed at all times to keep rain water out of tote and must be closed on pick-up day.
- Refuse bags outside of the toter will be picked up. However, an extra charge may apply.
- Grass must be placed in paper biodegradable bags (available locally) and placed next to toter.
- Large refuse pickup will be your regular refuse pickup day. Subject to \$5 to \$100 charge.
- Village will provide each household 1 toter and as many recycling bins as needed. They must be returned to the village should you move. Additional toters can be obtained subject to a monthly fee. Effective July 1, 2011 the fee is \$5. There is no charge for additional recycling bins.
- Street side pickup (this rule does not apply to alley pickup residents)
 - Toters cannot be placed beside curb more than 12 hours before day of collection.
 - Toters must be removed from curb within 24 hours after collection.
