Covington Utility Department to Provide On-line Invoice Services and Payment Options.

Beginning July 10th 2017, Covington utility customers will be able to access and pay their utility bills on-line.

Covington utility customers will use information obtained from their most recent utility bill to register as an online customer. Once registered, Covington customers may use the website to view past utility bills, and consumption data. Utility Customers also will have the ability to make payments on-line using their checking account or major credit card.

For your convenience, a link will be added to the Covington Village Website Utility Department page to allow customers to easily access the utility billing system. Customers with questions should contact the Government Center for Assistance.

In addition to the online payment system, the Village continues to offer automatic deductions from customer's checking accounts for the payment of utility bills.
