Community Garage Sales

Covington Community garage sales will be held on June 1, 2 and 3.

Large Item Pickup

The Village will again provide curb-side pickup of large items the week after the garage sales. This service will be provided to residential trash customers at no additional cost the week of June 5.

Summer Construction Projects

The Village of Covington is set to begin work on several construction projects. The long anticipated safe routes to school sidewalk project is set to begin the first week of June with the clearing of trees and removal of sidewalks and curbs within the project area of Chestnut, Ludlow and Broadway Streets. This project is scheduled to be completed by mid-July.

The Villages' annual sidewalk replacement program is also underway with a scheduled completion date of July 1st.

The summer paving program will be completed during the months of July and August. This year's repaving program includes Debra, Ullery and Chestnut street between Wenrick and Steven Streets.

Mosquito Control

If you have been watching the news you are probably aware of the growing concern for diseases such as West Nile and Zika which can be transmitted by mosquitos. The Village of Covington is continuing its mosquito fogging program again this year, but fogging alone is not enough. Standing water becomes a breeding ground for disease carrying mosquitos. Items such as used tires, buckets, or unused swimming pools may become a haven for thousands of mosquitos. We ask that each property owner check his or her property to be sure that all items or areas that allow standing water are eliminated. With your help, we can work to control the mosquito population in Covington.
