Public Hearings Have Been Scheduled to Receive Public Comments on Proposed Gas and Electric Aggregation Programs.

The Village of Covington in conjunction with the Newberry Township Trustees will hold two public hearings for public comment on the Village and Township's Natural Gas and Electric Power Aggregation Plans of Operation and Governance for the Municipal Gas and Electrical Aggregation. These public hearings are scheduled to be held on Monday, September 19, 2016 and Monday, October 17, 2016 at 6:30pm at Village of Covington's Municipal Building, 1 S. High St., Covington, OH 45318. The Village of Covington's Gas and Electric Power Aggregation Plans of Operation and Governance describes the policies and procedures by which the Village will carry out its Municipal Gas and Electric Aggregation Programs, including those policies and procedures which relate to rates and customer service. The Plan includes information on member education, opt-out procedures, billing, obligations of an electric supplier solicitation of bids, changes and termination of service and selection of an electric supplier. Community attendance and participation are encouraged.

Copies of the proposed plans are available for inspection at Village Hall during normal business hours.
