The following is the November 2016 Covington SRO Activity Report. November was an active month even though we had two long weekends over Veteran's Day Weekend and Thanksgiving.

To begin the month on November 2, I spoke to the Covington Noon Optimist Club regarding the School Resource Officer Position and how the new building has changed the daily responsibilities.

On November 10 and 17, I travelled to Bradford Exempted Village School's to continue on their A.L.I.C.E. Emergency Plan training that we taught to the staff in August. On the 10th I taught grades K-5 and the 17th was 6-12. The students were very well behaved and extremely interested in the new policy. The majority of the Elementary teachers had their students barricade their classrooms to teach them how to protect themselves during a school emergency.

On November 29, Chief Harmon, Superintendent Gene Gooding, and Building Principal's Josh Long, Rick Fry and Matt Pond met and spent the morning updating the School Safety Plan to put into place the best policies and procedures to serve our students, staff and visitors to the buildings.

November is also the end of the Fall Sports Season and the beginning of the Winter Sports Season. On Saturday, November 5, Covington High School hosted a Football Playoff Game against Hillcrest Academy. The Buccs won this game and advanced to the second round, at Piqua High School against Ft. The Lady Buccs pulled off the win in an action packed fun game to watch. On the 29th I also attended the Lady Buccs home game against Franklin Monroe, which was another win.
