Curbside Leaf Pickup will begin the week of October 5th and continue through the first week of December. Village staff will complete the curbside leaf pickup as their schedule allows. Yard waste should be placed in the leaf piles and will be picked up at the same time that leaves are picked up. Sticks and brush should be kept separate and should not be placed in the leaf piles.
